“Mini” Site Extended—Washington, North Carolina

This temporary site opened in November and is in response to the April 2014 tornadoes. Volunteers are needed for two week increments:

- Jan 17—31, Jan 31—Feb 14, Feb 14—28, Feb 28—Mar 14, Mar 14—Mar 28

This is basically a DRS-managed reconstruction site, with two noticeable differences:

- It is a two week assignment rather than the typical three, but you will be reimbursed as if it were a three week assignment (travel to and from).
- Accommodations: men and women sleep in separate quarters, bunkhouse style.
