A Calf—the simple power of milk

Bangladesh

Calves can be raised at home, and when they are fattened the meat can be sold to provide income. Or, when a calf is full-grown, it can provide an ongoing source of milk to drink or to sell in the market.

A Piglet—from home to market

Pigs can be reared and fed at home, then sold at market for food.

Senegal

Cooking in Senegal usually means cooking over an open flame, causing most of the heat to be lost and using a large amount of wood or charcoal. With a fuel-efficient stove, families can cook their food safely, using less wood and charcoal each year.


Proper Nutrition to Grow Strong and Healthy

A Treadle Pump—water in the dry season

Mozambique

In central Mozambique, a treadle pump gives farmers a way to water their crops in the dry season and significantly increases their harvest each year. This allows them to provide food for their families and sometimes have some left over to sell.

Stepping Stones training is an intensive and highly participatory 5-10 day program that gives communities the tools they need to understand the health and HIV/AIDS risks they face. It also addresses issues like gender disparity and family communication that significantly affect community health.




A Bicycle—the gift of transportation **1**


Empowering Women and Communities

A Microloan—small investment, big impact 2

Nigeria

Most of the world's poor are women, who have fewer educational opportunities and must also combat cultural biases. A microloan gives a woman the opportunity to start her own business, transforming her family's overall health and education. Women are also likely to reinvest earned income because of their connection to the family's needs.

Legal Assistance—justice for all! Nicaragua

A network of professional lawyers provides assistance to people who lack resources to pay for legal services. Legal issues can be related to land disputes, employer/employee disputes, human rights abuses, and domestic violence. World Renew supports this network by providing assistance for transportation, professional training, and some legal processes.

International

A goat serves as an asset for many families, sold to cover expenses as they arise. World Renew distributes goats to disaster survivors whose livestock have been sold or lost because of the disaster, helping them to reestablish their assets. Each recipient then gives the first goat kid to a neighbor in need, growing the impact of your gift.

Note: The cost of a goat has risen in the last year due to increases in program costs such as veterinary care, goat care training, and animal feed.



What Does the Maple Leaf Mean?

The maple leaf symbol indicates an item that will receive matching funds from the Canadian government through the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA). CIDA has committed to providing World Renew with more than \$7 million in funding over the next five years, provided that World Renew raises a portion of the program costs from individuals and churches in Canada. At a ratio of 3:1, every dollar you donate toward these programs will result in four dollars raised for renewal around the world.
