

Give Water and Sanitation

How do you get a drink of water? Walk to a sink and turn on the faucet, right? For many people the world over, getting water requires a daily long walk with a heavy bucket. In many places there isn't a reliable source of clean drinking water. In still other places, water supplies have dried up due to drought. World Renew works with communities to improve their access to clean water. both by providing new sources of water through treadle pumps and wells and by providing water filters to purify water. World Renew also helps communities improve sanitation through the installation of latrines.

Give Livestock

Animals act as live "piggy banks" for a family—livestock are an asset they can sell to pay for an unexpected trip to the medical clinic or to buy food during times of drought. Calves and goats are part of World Renew's livestock multiplication program. Here's how it works: a few families in each community are given a calf or goat kid. When the mature animal produces offspring, recipients keep one young animal and give the remaining calves and goat kids to other needy households in the community. In this way, each livestock gift from the gift catalog multiplies and blesses many individuals and families.

Nutritious food, Clean air, Good health. We sometimes take these gifts for granted in North America. Yet millions of people around the world are malnourished, both physically and spiritually. Through World Renew's health programs, HIV testing kits lead to earlier diagnosis and better treatment for HIV-positive individuals. Nutrition kits are distributed to children in Honduras, improving their health and ability to focus on their chores and schoolwork. Chimneys are installed in homes around the world, delivering wood smoke to the outdoors and greatly improving the quality of indoor air.

Sometimes people have a great desire to change their lives but they lack the means. By working with others in the community, a woman can take out a small loan to start a business. Little by little she can repay the loan, allowing another community member to borrow money to do the same. As her business grows, she can take another loan to make another positive change, perhaps this time buying a chicken in order to sell the eggs to pay for her child's school tuition. Livelihood gifts like this can mean the difference between a dream staying a dream and a dream becoming a reality.


